Itinerary Details



We will be traveling on Cruise Tour #15 with Royal Caribbean

Day 1 – Saturday, July 9

We will board our flight to travel to **Fairbanks, Alaska**. Upon arrival we will be transferred to the hotel and the rest of the evening will be at your leisure.

Day 2 – Sunday, July 10

Let the touring begin!! Your day is filled with exciting activities while on a **Fairbanks City Tour, including a tour of the El Dorado Gold Mine** where you can pan for gold. Then in the afternoon, enjoy a cruise on the **Riverboat Discovery Sternwheeler**. Both tours are included with your package. The rest of the evening will be at your leisure.

Day 3 – Monday, July 11

This morning we will depart Fairbanks in route to **Denali National Park**. Travel on the **Wilderness Express**, Royal Caribbean's glass-domed train cars, through spectacular wilderness to Denali. In the afternoon, take the exciting **Tundra Wilderness Tour** deep into Denali National Park. Keep an eye out for caribou, moose, bear and other wildlife along your path. The Tundra Wilderness Tour is included in your package. The rest of your evening will be at your leisure at Denali.

Day 4 - Tuesday, July 12

Your morning is open for optional activities, such as Nenana River Rafting. In the afternoon, put on your headset, sit back and relax onboard the Wilderness Express, on a scenic journey to **Talkeetna**. Then enjoy a relaxing evening in front of the fireplace at the Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge.

Day 5 – Wednesday, July 13

Spend the morning independently exploring the exciting areas surrounding Talkeetna or enjoying an optional activity, such as sport fishing or flightseeing. Later in the day, relax on your deluxe motorcoach as you head for **Anchorage**. Upon arrival in Anchorage the rest of the day will be at your leisure.

Day 6 – Thursday, July 14

In the morning, enjoy an **Anchorage city tour, including a visit to the Alaska Native Heritage Center**, where you'll learn about Alaska's first people. In the afternoon, travel by deluxe motorcoach to Alyeska. Spend the night in luxury at The Hotel Alyeska.

Day 7 – Friday, July 15

In the morning, experience breathtaking views as you soar 2,300 feet above the valley on the **Alyeska Tramway**. In the afternoon, travel by deluxe motorcoach to historic **Seward**. There, you'll board the Radiance of the Seas to begin your cruise adventure.

Day 8 – Saturday, July 16

Enjoy a full day at sea. During the afternoon the ship will cruise the **Hubbard Glacier** and provide many scenic views for all passengers to enjoy.

Day 9 – Sunday, July 17

Enjoy your day in **Juneau**, the capital city of Alaska. Today you will have plenty of free time to enjoy this former gold mining town, nestled at the foot of Mt. Juneau in the Alaskan Panhandle. Shore excursion options include:

- Historic Juneau Gold Mine Tour
- Four Glacier Adventure by Helicopter
- Juneau Sport fishing
- Mendenhall Glacier and Salmon Hatchery

Day 10 – Monday, July 18

Welcome to **Skagway**! Enjoy a full day to explore the city that was founded after the famous Gold Rush of 1898. You will have plenty of time to explore on your own or take advantage of the many shore excursions offered by the cruise line. Shore excursion options include:

- Dog sledding & Glacier Flight seeing
- The White Pass Scenic Railroad
- Skagway City & Garden Tour

Day 11 – Tuesday, July 19

This morning the ship will anchor offshore and you will have the opportunity to tender into **Icy Strait Point**. Icy Strait Point is located near the city of Hoonah, the largest native Tlingit Indian settlement in Alaska, and very near Glacier Bay National Park. Home to a historic cannery, the port's connection to the sea is strong. Locals share the sea with humpback whales, orcas, Dall porpoises, seals, sea otters, halibut and all five species of Pacific salmon. It is not uncommon to spot a humpback or an orca while walking along the shore. Shore excursion options include:

- Visit the Alaskan Botanical Gardens
- Take a flightseeing tour of spectacular Glacier Bay
- Explore the Native Tlingit historical park, museum and theater for an interesting
- Take a ride on the world's longest zip-line!

Day 12 – Wednesday, July 20

Today explore the town of **Ketchikan**, which originated as an Indian slat fishery before becoming a bustling port during the Gold Rush of 1898. There is much history to explore in the town especially in the many nearby Indian villages. Shore excursion options include:

- Totem Bight State Park and Town Tour
- Misty Fjords Seaplane Adventure
- Alaska Bear Adventure
- Historical Waterfront Cruise

Day 13 – Thursday, July 21

Enjoy your last day at sea aboard the Radiance of the Seas **Cruising the Inside Passage**. Take time to sit out on deck and enjoy the beautiful scenery go by. Many onboard activities will be available for you to enjoy throughout the day.

Day 14 –Friday, July 22

After breakfast onboard the ship you will be transferred back to the airport by motor coach for your return flight home.



We will have two days to experience the Wilderness Express during the land portion of our cruise tour.

Proof of Citizenship Information

Please be advised that everyone must have a current U.S. Passport in order to travel.

Fuel Surcharge Information

While there is currently no fuel surcharge in place, please be advised that Royal Caribbean can implement fuel surcharges at anytime. For US reservations, Royal Caribbean International reserves the right to impose a fuel supplement on all guests if the price of West Texas Intermediate fuel exceeds \$65.00 USD per barrel. The fuel supplement for 1st and 2nd guests would be no more than \$10 USD per guest per day, to a maximum of \$140 USD per cruise; and for additional guests would be no more than \$5 USD per person per day, to a maximum of \$70 USD per cruise.
